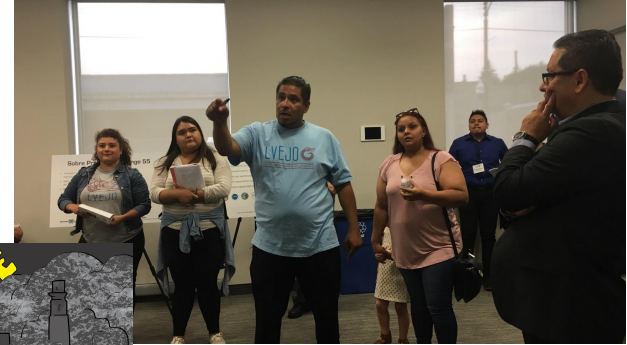
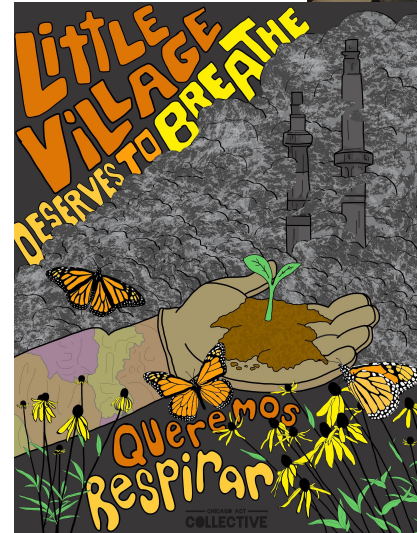

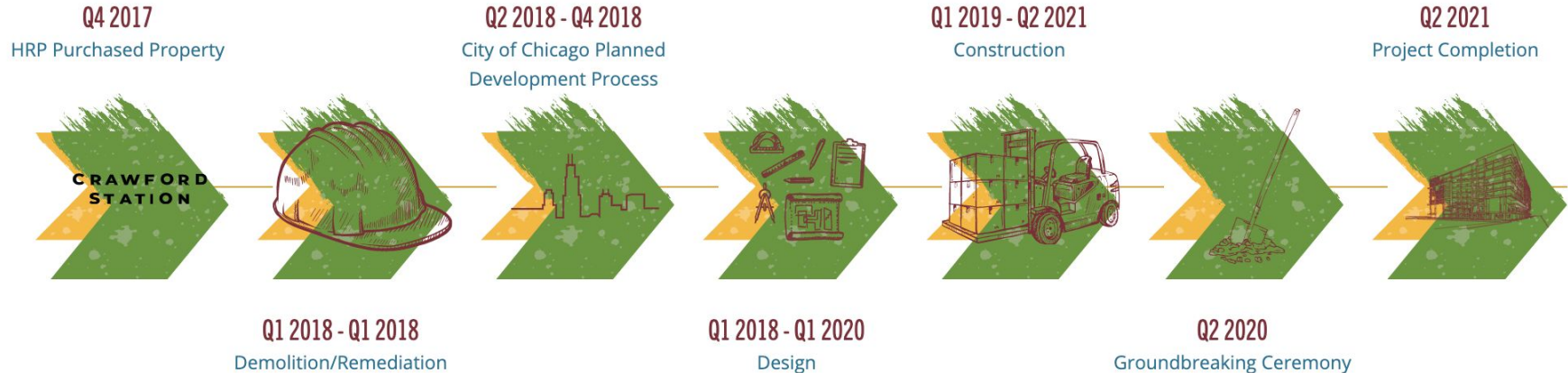

Mi Villita found out in the Fall of 2020:

- 2,500 gallon **DIESEL** tanker approved for placement at the northeast corner of the site (nearest 33rd between Ridgeway & Hamlin)
- Building is 600 ft wide x 1,668 ft in length
 - Footage decreased to 1,023,467 sq. ft.
 - Loading and unloading will happen on the east side of the loading dock
- Vehicular parking **INCREASED** to **1,058** spaces to accommodate employee parking*
- **Reduction** in trailer stalls by 142

Environmental Impacts // Impactos Ambientales

Air, Soil and Water Impacts Update:

- **Water Filter Program** for community members impacted by water shut offs, COVID and the water line disturbances start this week. *Distribution is based on outreach done during this past summer.*
 - August 2020: Community members' water lines were tested by the City after receiving reports that their water quality had been impacted by Hilco's botched demolition of the Crawford Power Plant smoke stack.
 - The city checked the water main and discovered that it had been disrupted due to the strong shaking of the land when demolition happened. The valves on the water mains doors closed, leaving stagnant water since April 11.
 - After opening the valves, water was able to run through and community members saw a positive change in their water quality.
 - The City's water tests showed that for homes who underwent the water quality check there were no reports of any toxins found (Lead specifically)
Due to covid-19 water testing was only done on a handful of homes, as most folks didn't feel comfortable getting their water tested at the moment
- **Sanitation and Ship Canal** sediment analysis has showed heavy contamination from California Ave to Cicero. Working to break down and understand more about data.

Environmental Impacts // Impactos Ambientales

The City was ill-prepared for the demolition that occurred on April 11th. We can continue to push developers to be better neighbors and take our lives into consideration, but they will continue to take shortcuts so long as the City allows them to and this was the case with the implosion.

There was no air monitoring required for the demolition of the Crawford site, even though we have been DEMANDING fence line air monitoring from before the demolition even began.

Because the Crawford Coal Power Plant was such an old building (and burned coal), the City should have prepared for speciating particulate matter (PM) to understand their chemical composition. We basically want to understand, to the smallest detail, what was in the dust and how it can harm us.

Dr. Alison Arwady “assured” community members during the May 23rd community meeting by the Chicago DOB, that the levels of particulate matter in Little Village would not put them at a higher risk of lung damage or COVID-19. She said the levels of dust would not increase their risk.

Site Monitoring and Test Results

We understand Chicagoans in every neighborhood are concerned about air quality, especially in communities with a history of industrial activity, like Little Village. The City of Chicago is committed to keeping residents safe and healthy and will hold anyone violating clean air laws accountable. That is why we are working in partnership with US Environmental Protection Agency and Illinois Environmental Protection Agency to monitor air quality and dust in the area of the Crawford Site, both after the implosion of the Crawford smokestack and until all demolition of the Crawford site is complete.

Testing of air, dust and soil was conducted by two governmental agencies following the demolition by implosion:

- Chicago Department of Public Health (CDPH)
- US Environmental Protection Agency (US EPA)

Current Monitoring

Chicago Department of Public Health (CDPH) installed 7 dust monitors around the perimeter of the site and in the neighborhood. The monitors measure particulate matter, including PM₁₀ and PM_{2.5}, from 7 am to 7 pm every day. [View monitor locations here](#) and [read daily reports here](#).

Because this is a public health concern, the particulate action levels are based on the NAAQS value of 150 µm/mg3 PM10. An exceedance of the action level for 5 minutes is an indicator of dust leaving the site and will prompt dust control measures, such as wetting the area.

CDPH also installed Purple Air sensors at City properties in the neighborhood around Crawford between April 21 and April 24 to provide continuous, real-time measurements of particulate matter. 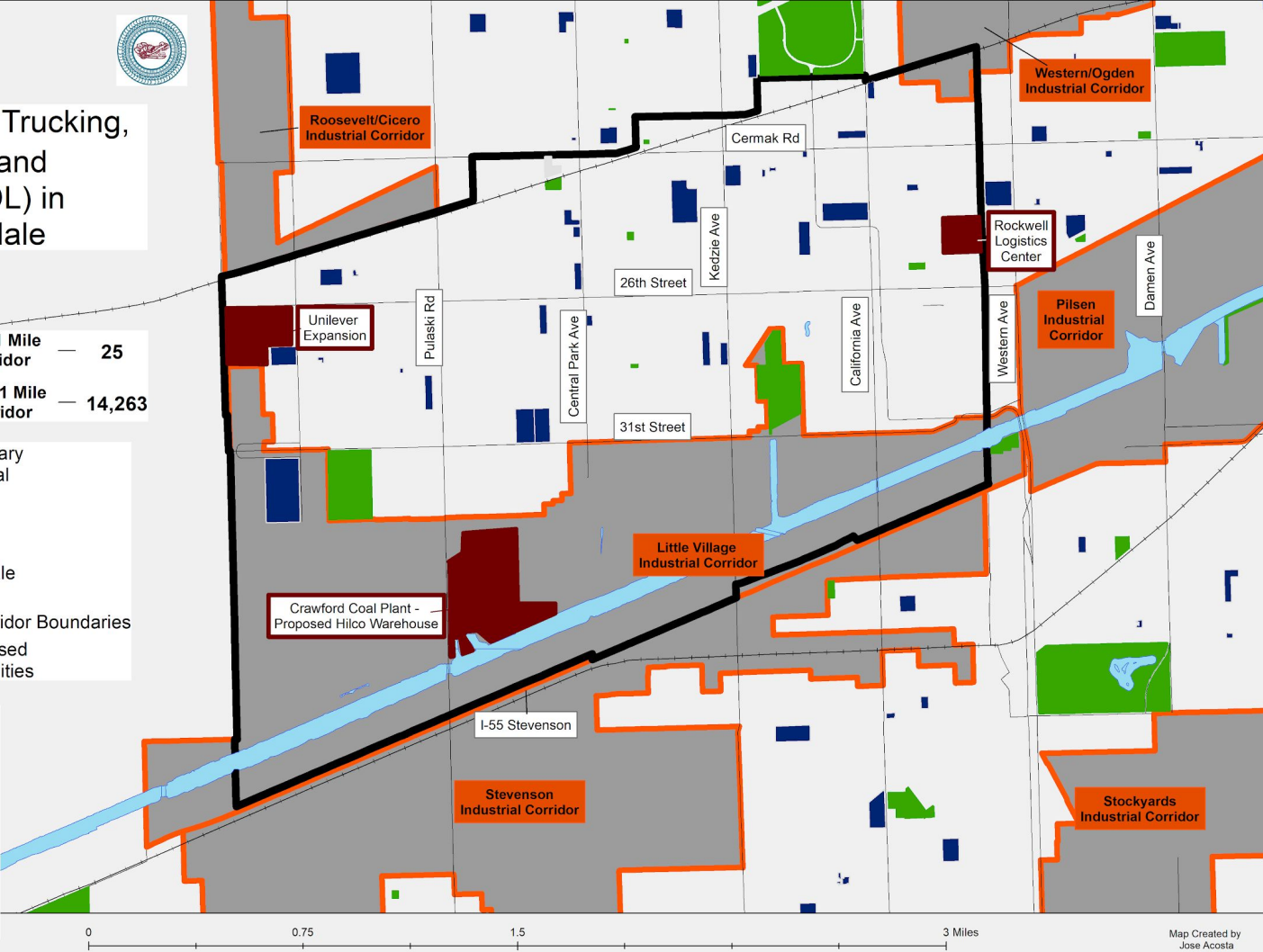


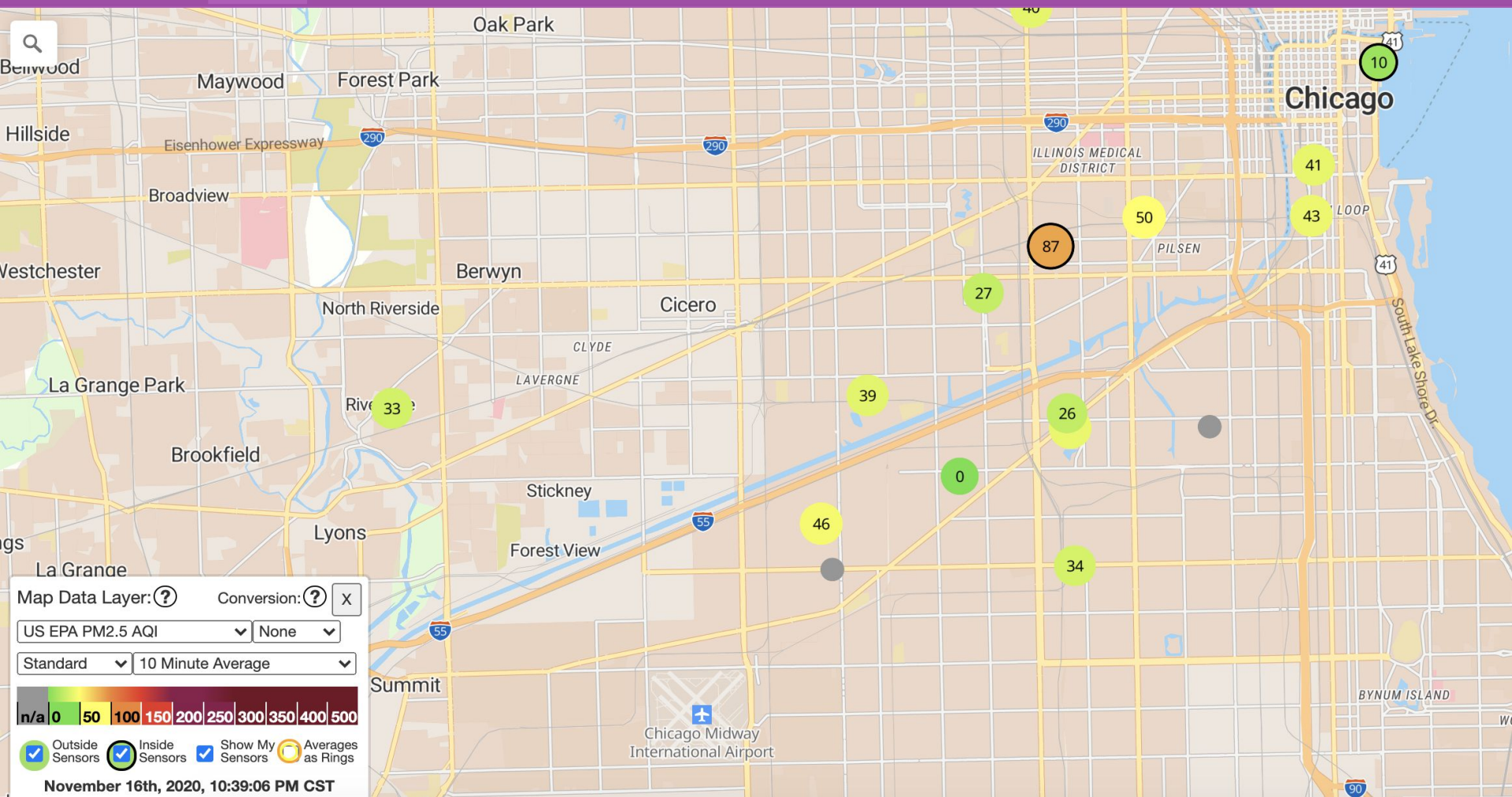
Schools and Trucking, Distribution, and Logistics (TDL) in South Lawndale

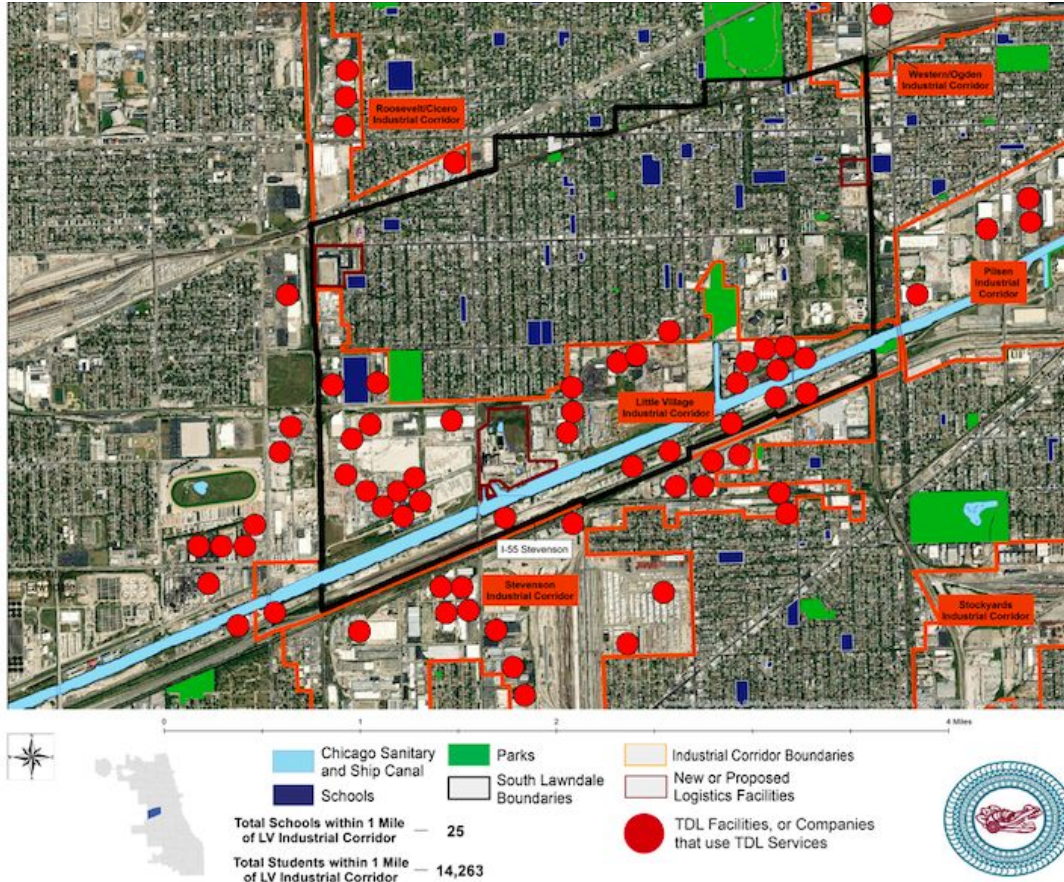
Southwest Freight/Semi-Truck Study

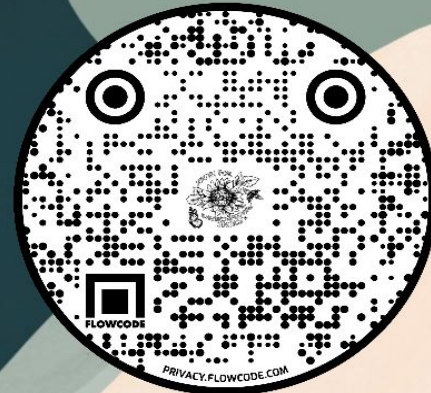
